### II. The Assembly of God

A. The protoevangelium, Gen. 3:15.

B. The Exodus Redemption, Ex. 7:15-16,12.

1. God's plan for His people, Ex. 7:15-16.

- Called out of Egypt to serve Yahweh.
- Redeemed from bondage.
- The salvation of the Red Sea Crossing.
- Persecution and protection in the desert of Sin.
  - Yahweh provides water at Marah, Massah & Meribah.
  - Yahweh provides manna and quail in the desert.
  - Persecution from the Amalekites.

2. The makeup of God's people, Isa. 10:22, Rom. 9:6-8.

3. The assembly of God at the Passover, Ex. 12:1-6.

עֲדָתָהּ ('adat) - A gathering by appointment or congregation: seems to refer to the congregation of Israel whether assembled or not.

קְהָלָהּ (qahal) - An assembly: seems to refer to an actual assembly of the people of God.

4. The great "day of assembly", the gathering of the קְהָלָהּ, Deut. 9:10; Ex. 19:1-6, 10-13,16-20.

### C. Other great assemblies.

1. Regular assemblies at the door of the Tent of Meeting, Lev. 8:3-4, 16:33-34.
2. Trouble among God's people, Num. 16:1-3, 19-24, 31-35.
3. Joshua reaffirms the covenant at Mt. Ebal, Josh. 8:30-35.
4. David's assembly to assure Solomon's succession, 1Chron. 28:8-10.
5. Solomon's dedication of the temple before the ark, 2Chr. 6:1-3, 12-13, 7:1-3.
6. Hezekiah purifies the temple, 2Chron. 30:23-27.

### D. The agony and hope of the assembly.

1. The exile and preservation of a remnant, 2Chr. 36:11-23, Ezra 1:1-6.
2. The voices of the prophets, Joel 2:12-16, 23-32, Mal. 4:4-6.
