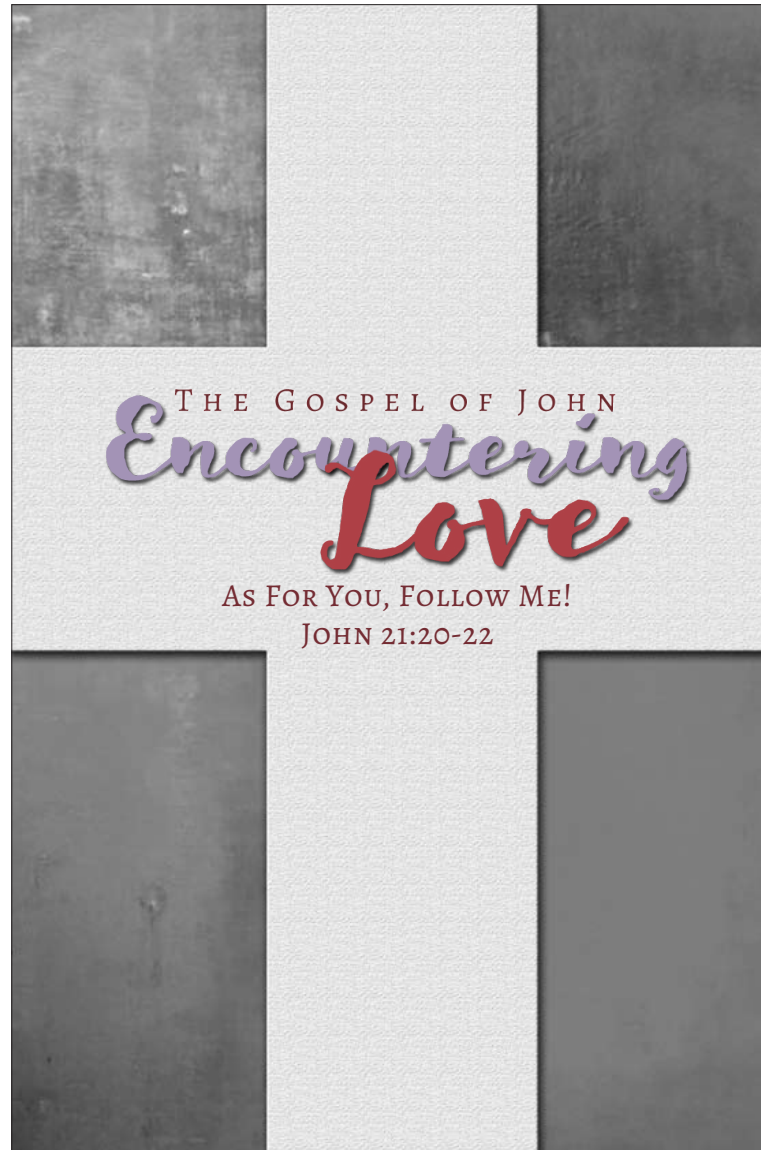

The Ten Commandments

You shall have no other gods before me.
