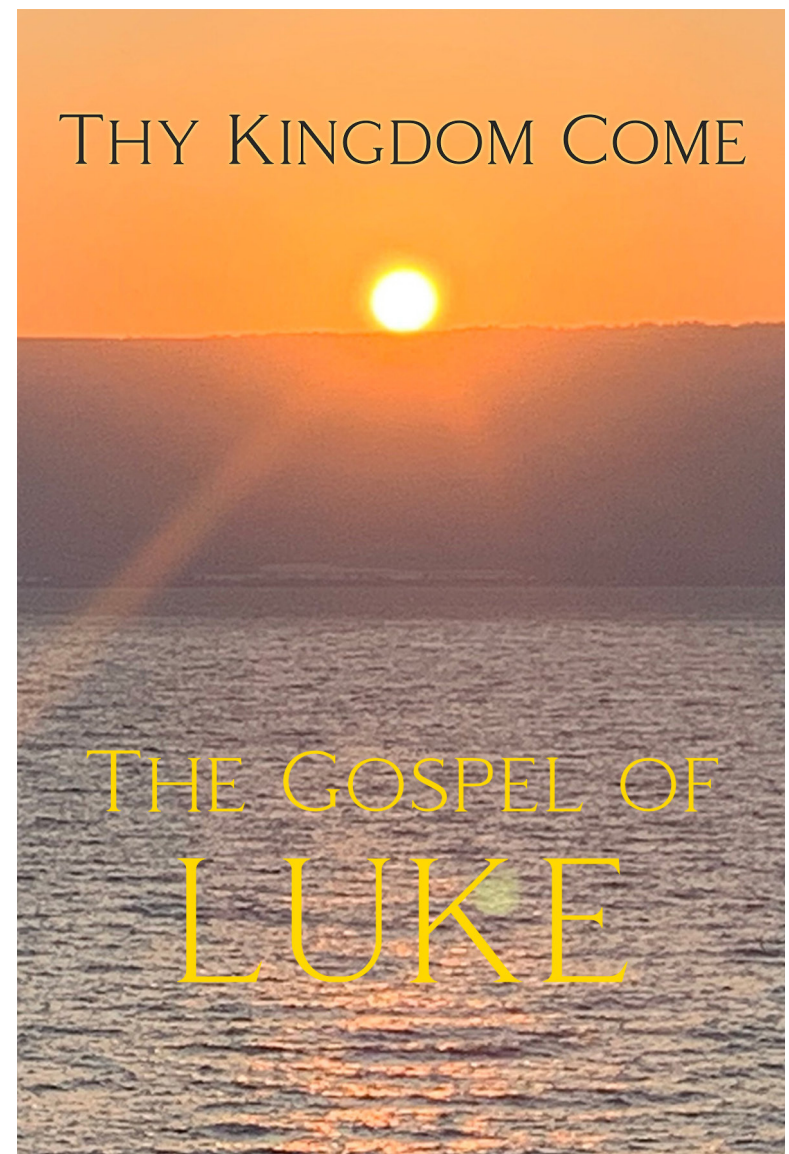

Heidelberg Catechism: Lord's Day 30 #82

[Pastor:] Should those be admitted to the Lord's Supper who show by what they say and do that they are unbelieving and ungodly?

[All:] No, that would dishonor God's covenant and bring down God's wrath upon the entire congregation. Therefore, according to the instruction of Christ and his apostles, the Christian church is duty-bound to exclude such people, by the official use of the keys of the kingdom, until they reform their lives.
