

[Pastor:] Arise, O Lord, and go to your resting place, you and the ark of your might. {Psa. 132:8)

Heidelberg Catechism: Lord's Day 40

[Pastor:] What is God's will for us in the sixth commandment?

[All:] I am not to belittle, insult, hate, or kill my neighbor not by my thoughts, my words, my look, or gesture and certainly not by actual deeds and I am not to be party to this in others; rather, I am to put away all desire for revenge. I am not to harm or recklessly endanger myself either. Prevention of murder is also why government is armed with the sword.

[Pastor:] Does this commandment refer only to murder?

[All:] God's prohibition of murder teaches us that God hates the root of murder: envy, hatred, anger, vindictiveness. In God's sight all such are hidden murder.

[Pastor:] Is it enough then that we not murder our neighbor in any such way?

[All:] No. By condemning envy, hatred, and anger God wants us to love our neighbors as ourselves, to show patience,

peace, gentleness, mercy, and friendliness towards them, to protect them from harm as much as we can, and to do good even to our enemies.
