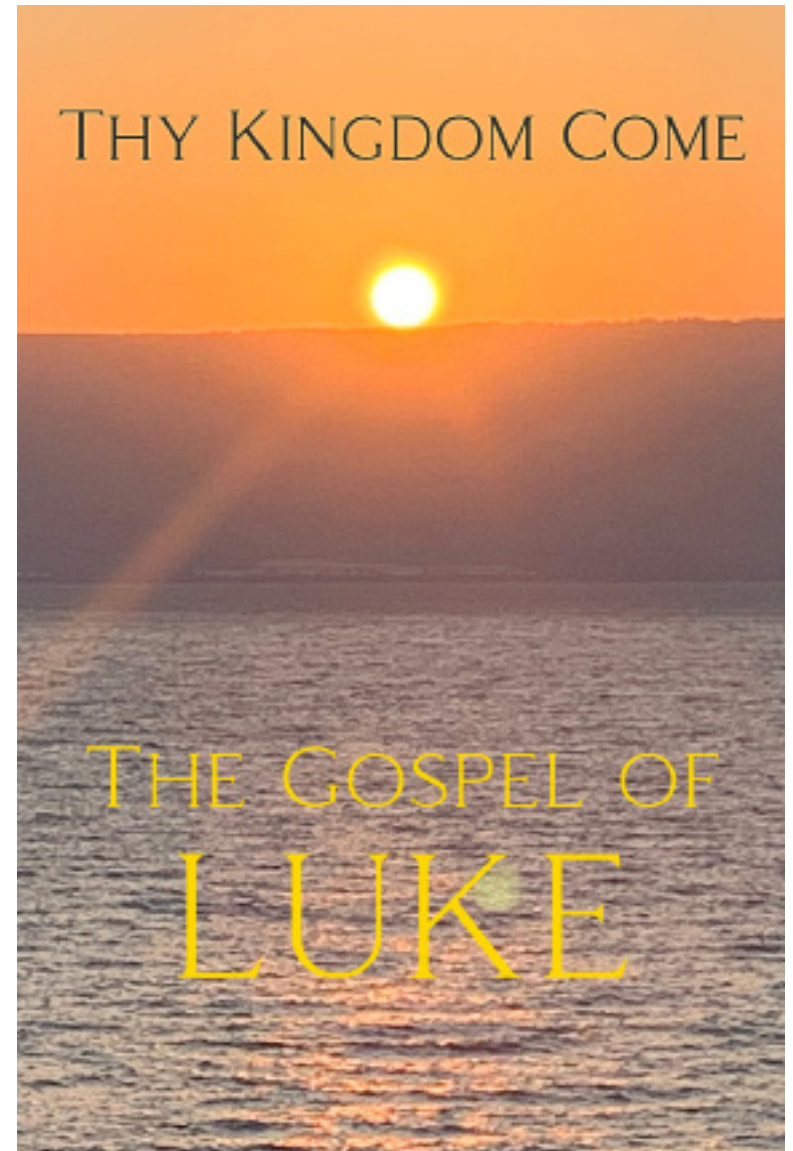

Scripture Reference: Luke 11:29–32 (ESV)

Luke 11:29. When the crowds were increasing, he began to say, "This generation is an evil generation. It seeks for a sign, but no sign will be given to it except the sign of Jonah.

Luke 11:30. For as Jonah became a sign to the people of Nineveh, so will the Son of Man be to this generation.

Luke 11:31. The queen of the South will rise up at the judgment with the men of this generation and condemn them, for she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon, and behold, something greater than Solomon is here.

Luke 11:32. The men of Nineveh will rise up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it, for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and behold, something greater than Jonah is here.

Synopsis: "On Love And Judgment"

In this second part of Luke's discussion of the danger of "seeking signs" we will find ourselves once again analyzing the "sign of Jonah" and how it relates to Christ as a sign of both judgment and redemption. Our study will be aided by two illustrations Jesus gives of the condemnation incurred when the clear revelation of God through His Revealed Word is ignored. While pondering God's motivation for sending Jonah to Nineveh, we will once again realize the close correlation with Jesus' mission and purpose in coming to the "silent planet". We will find that even in the preaching of impending Judgment, God's mercy and compassion is manifest. Ultimately we will recognize yet a third objective of the "Cosmic Initiative"--- for Jesus to introduce the world to the unfathomable Love of the Father.
