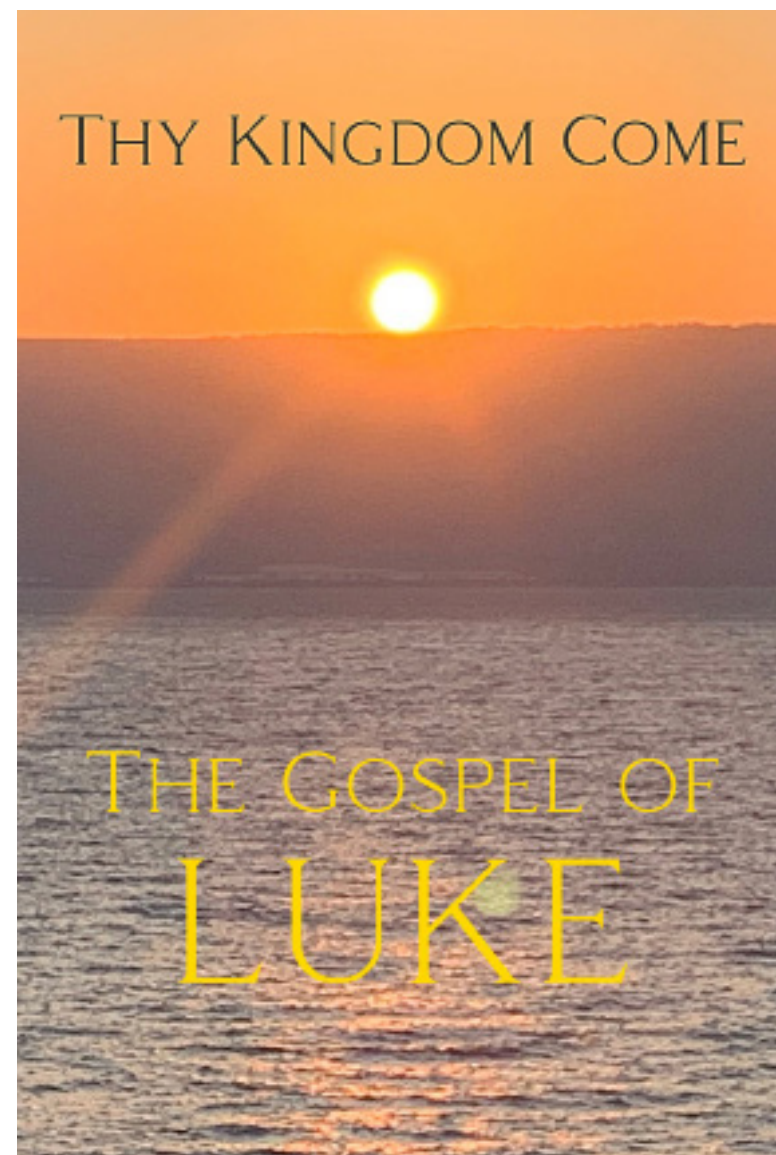

Luke 12:8. And I tell you, everyone who acknowledges me before men, the Son of Man also will acknowledge before the angels of God,

Luke 12:9. but the one who denies me before men will be denied before the angels of God.

Synopsis: "Crucial Christological Confessions"

After warning His disciples to beware of the hypocrisy and evil-intent of the Pharisees, Jesus reassured them they had nothing to fear from the world, but that wisdom dictated they fear God, fear hell and "run" to Him as the only One who could save them from the one and reconcile them to the Other. He then highlights the importance of His mediatory role, in our text for this message, by effectively dividing the world into two distinct groups-- those who will acknowledge Him before men and those who will not. This becomes crucial when Jesus reveals it will determine whether He will acknowledge them before His Father at the Final Judgment. We will look carefully at the meaning of these words and seek to clearly define what it means to "acknowledge" Christ and what it means to "deny" Him. Ultimately we will realize there is nothing more important in life or death than these two crucial confessions. First, the one you must make for Christ in this life. And secondly, the one Jesus must make on behalf of you as a condemned sinner at the Final Judgment. For it is these crucial Christological confessions that will determine your eternity!

A Christological Confession

- I confess and believe that Christ is the long awaited Messiah so clearly foreseen by the prophets of the Old Testament.
- I confess and believe that Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit of God and was born of a virgin.
- I confess and believe that Christ came as one person with two distinct natures-- both wholly God and wholly man.
- I confess and believe that Christ is the Logos, He is Emmanuel, He is God with us.
- I confess and believe that Christ alone is the "way, the truth and the life" and that "no one comes to the Father" except through Him!
- I confess and believe that as a man Christ was tempted just as I am tempted, and yet that He never sinned-- living a life of perfect righteousness.
- I confess and believe that Christ voluntarily went to the Cross as a Sacrificial, Substitutionary Atonement for my sins.
- I confess and believe that God in His wrath against my sin punished Christ eternally while on that cross. That by His stripes, I AM HEALED.
- I confess and believe that when Christ said, "It is finished;" payment for every one of my sins was complete.
- I confess and believe that because of this sacrifice and the infinite grace of God, my sins are forgiven and I am reconciled with God.
- I confess and believe that Christ's human body died on that Cross, and was placed in a tomb, where He never saw corruption.

- I confess and believe Christ is there even now, as my Mediator, my Intercessor, my Shepherd, my Brother, my Savior, my Salvation, my Sanctification, and my King.
- I confess and believe Christ has prepared a place for me, so that where He is-- there I might be also.
- I confess and believe Christ will come again to this silent planet in power, glory, and judgment, with His mighty angels.
- I confess and believe that at that time every knee will bow and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord!"
