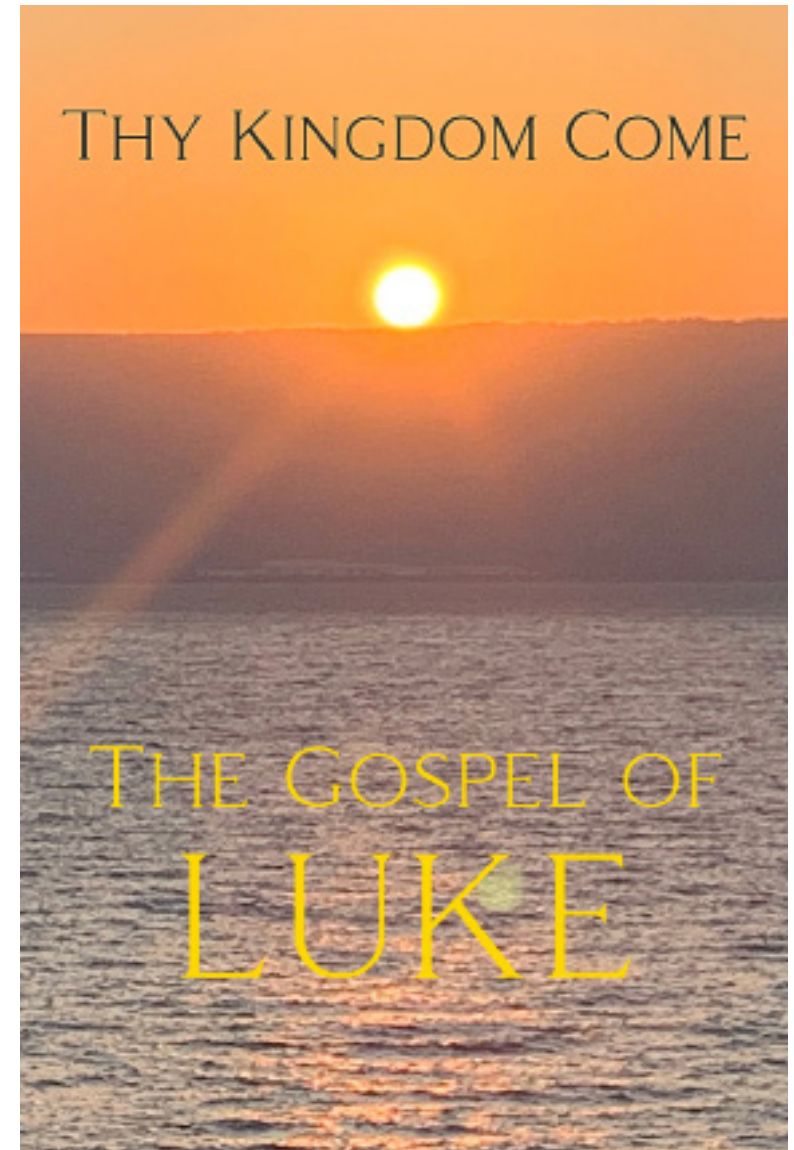

Scripture Reference: Luke 12:22–28 (ESV)

Luke 12:22. And he said to his disciples, "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on.

Luke 12:23. For life is more than food, and the body more than clothing.

Luke 12:24. Consider the ravens: they neither sow nor reap, they have neither storehouse nor barn, and yet God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds!

Luke 12:25. And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life?

Luke 12:26. If then you are not able to do as small a thing as that, why are you anxious about the rest?

Luke 12:27. Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

Luke 12:28. But if God so clothes the grass, which is alive in the field today, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more will he clothe you, O you of little faith!

Synopsis: "Dealing With Dread"

Immediately after His scathing commentary on covetousness, Jesus addresses one of the greatest problems facing humankind in our day-to-day lives: the ever-present problem of anxiety. We will look at this from two perspectives: specific anxieties that are the result of some problem or calamity, and non-specific anxieties that manifest themselves as a vague indiscernible dread that hangs like Damocles' sword over our heads and cripples us as disciples of Christ. We will explore Jesus' three illustrations as to why we should not be anxious and take comfort in His reassuring words of how to deal with dread. Ultimately we will realize that anxiety is another attempt, like covetousness, to control God's Providence and is therefore a spiritual problem of faith.
