

# Scripture Reference: Luke 15:1-10 (ESV)

Luke 15:1. Now the tax collectors and sinners were all drawing near to hear him.

Luke 15:2. And the Pharisees and the scribes grumbled, saying, "This man receives sinners and eats with them."

Luke 15:3. So he told them this parable:

Luke 15:4. What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it?

Luke 15:5. And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. Luke 15:6. And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost.'

Luke 15:7. Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.

Luke 15:8. Or what woman, having ten silver coins, if she loses one coin, does not light a lamp and sweep the house and seek diligently until she finds it?

Luke 15:9. And when she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost.' Luke 15:10. Just so, I tell you, there is joy before the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

# Synopsis: "The Joy of Restoration"

The great themes of Luke's Gospel continue to ebb and flow as the mission and purpose of Jesus' Cosmic Initiative comes back into focus. Noticing the grumbling of the religious elite over His ministry to the "riffraff" they ignored and disdained, Jesus tells two delightful parables that highlight the reason He came and how important the lost elect are to Him-- whoever and wherever they may be. We will analyze these parables carefully, finding in them essential principles for the church. In the first one, a shepherd who loses one of his sheep, risks his entire flock to find it. The emphasis is on the sovereignty of the seeker, the importance of the one, and the joy to be found in its restoration. The second parable, of a woman who loses a coin and searches diligently until she finds it, will emphasize and strengthen these principles. Jesus has come to seek and save the lost and will continue to search for them, whether during His earthly ministry or through His church that will follow, until the last one is found and brought into the fold. Ultimately we will see where the emphasis of both these parables lies-- not just in the search and rescue of the lost, but in their joyful restoration to the very image of their Master.
