Scripture Reference: Romans 8:28–34 (ESV)

Romans 8:28. And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

Romans 8:29. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

Romans 8:30. And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified.

Romans 8:31. What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

Romans 8:32. He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

Romans 8:33. Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.

Romans 8:34. Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us

Synopsis: “Before the Throne of God Above”

Where is our Lord Jesus today, the man Jesus? He is seated at the right hand of the Father, in the highest position of honor. He is our representative and intercessor before God, and we are united with Him. When God looks at us, He sees the righteousness of Jesus. Because of this, we are forgiven, cleansed, and declared just for eternity.

Romans 8 speaks to this assurance for believers. This truth is practical for our daily lives: we can rest confidently, knowing that nothing can ever condemn us. Even in times of tribulation, we find comfort, as we are in His hands and our future is secure in Him.

For a Christian, there is no condemnation—ever. Our salvation is secure.

Moment in the Word: Romans 8:1-4

Romans 8:1. There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Romans 8:2. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:3. For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh,

Romans 8:4. in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
