

Scripture Reference: Psalm 81:10 (ESV)

Psa. 81:10. I am the Lord your God, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt. Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.

Synopsis: "Open Wide Your Mouth... and God Will Fill It"

Pastor Jephthe preaches. The message is a divine reminder that God is not only our Deliverer, but also our Provider. The verse is both a declaration and an invitation. God identifies Himself as the one who rescued His people from bondage, establishing His power, faithfulness, and covenant love. But He doesn't stop there. He invites His people to open their mouths wide in faith, expectation, and dependence, promising to fill them. I will explore what it means to truly "open wide our mouth" before God: to trust Him boldly, to pray without limit, to hunger for His Word, and to position ourselves for overflow.

A36. The benefits which in this life do accompany or flow from justification, adoption, and sanctification, are, assurance of God's love, peace of conscience, joy in the Holy Ghost, increase of grace, and perseverance therein to the end.

Q37. What benefits do believers receive from Christ at death?

A37. The souls of believers are at their death made perfect in holiness, and do immediately pass into glory; and their bodies, being still united to Christ, do rest in their graves till the resurrection.

D. He Invites Our Faith. Our capacity to receive is tied to our willingness to ask.
