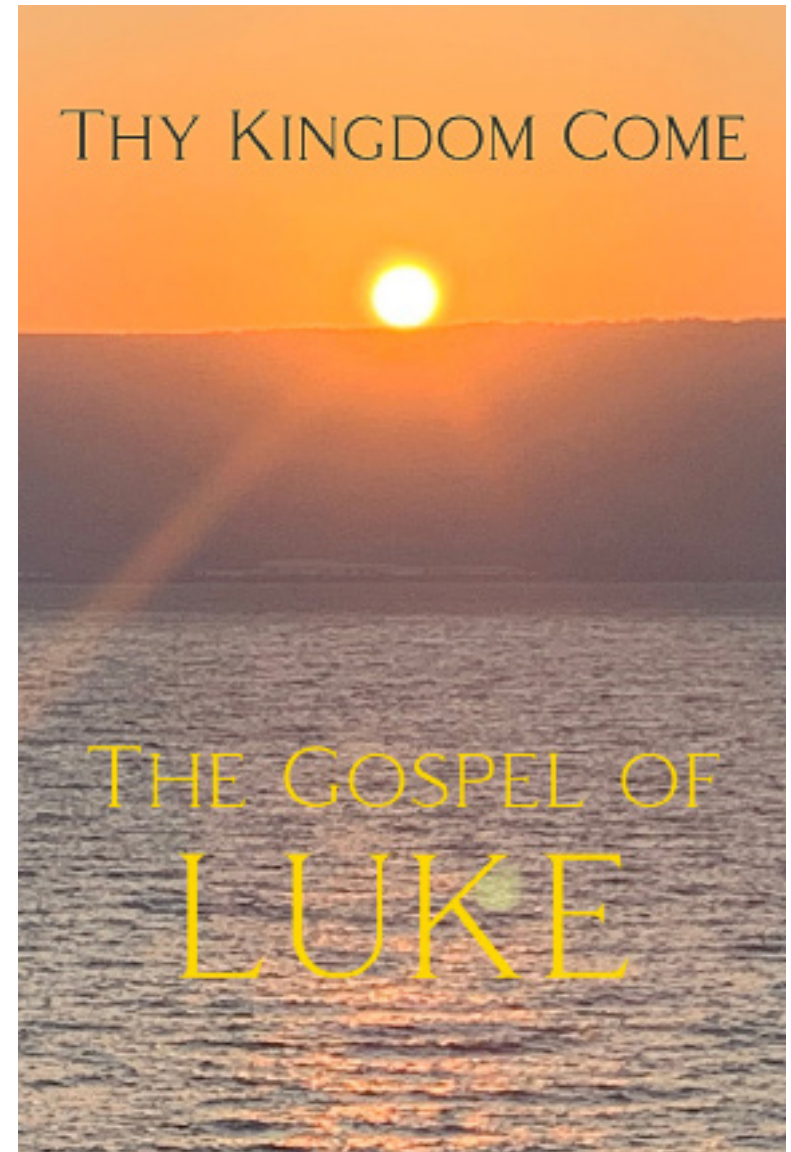

Scripture Reference: Luke 24:28-32 (ESV)

Luke 24:28. So they drew near to the village to which they were going. He acted as if he were going farther,

Synopsis: "Hearts Afire"

As Luke's narrative of the Road to Emmaus comes to its dramatic conclusion, the traveling companions consisting of Jesus and two disciples reach their destination. Along the way Jesus has perfectly expounded the Old Testament Scriptures to reveal why it was necessary that the Messiah suffer. Even though the two men still do not recognize Jesus, they almost forcefully insist that He stay with them awhile and enjoy a meal together. During the traditional breaking of the bread, the minds and hearts of the men are opened and they recognize Jesus as the Resurrected Christ. Immediately, He vanished from their sight-- leaving their hearts aflame with the power of His perfect exposition. We will analyze this incredible scene, noticing the many principles and lessons it contains. But ultimately, we will ask ourselves what sets our own hearts afire. And if it is not the Word of God as illuminated by the Holy Spirit-- why not?
