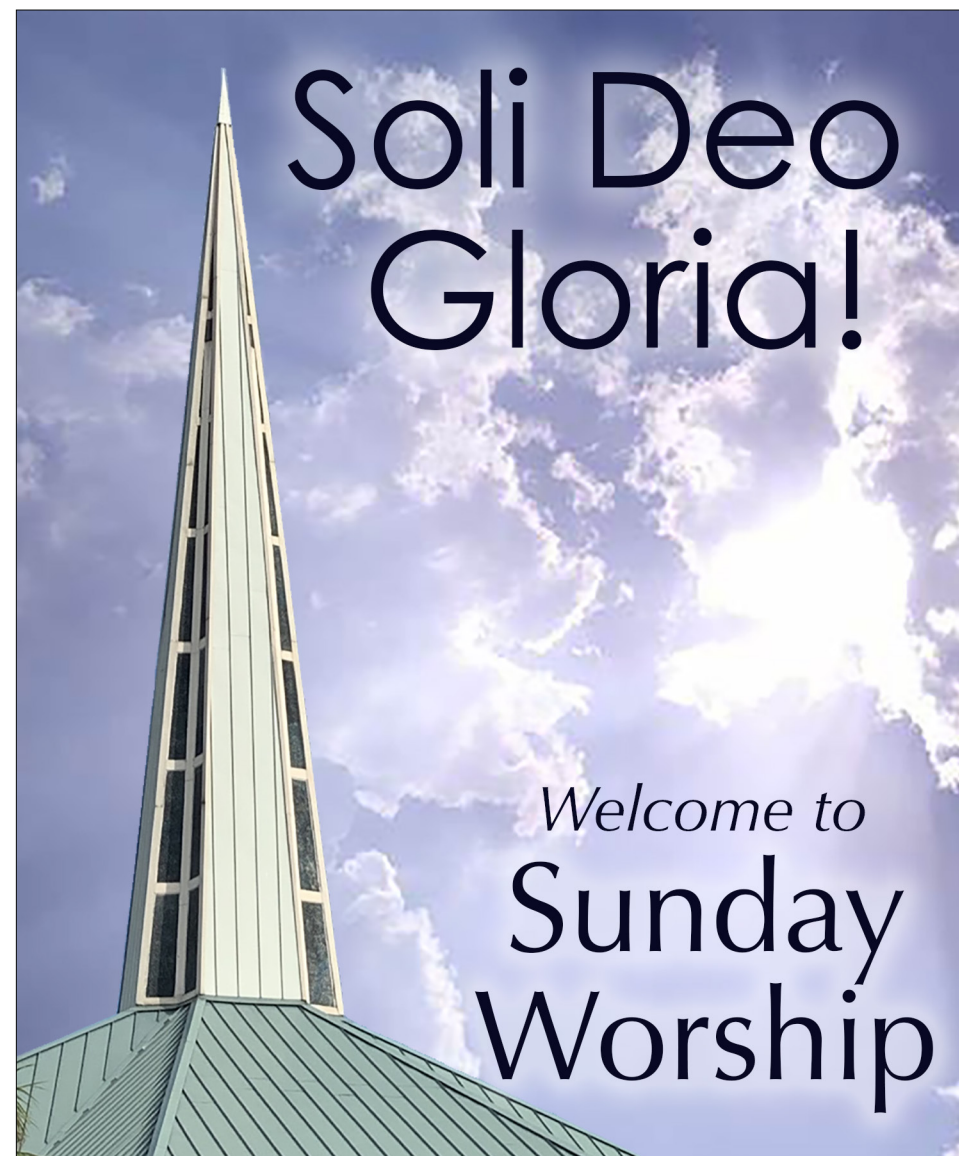

Synopsis: "Prepare Yourself for the New Season"

In Isaiah 43, God asks His people to prepare for a new season. Because they are redeemed, loved, and protected, He urges them to stop dwelling on the past and to look forward in faith. Through the promise, "Behold, I will do a new thing" (Isa. 43:19), God assures them that He can make a way where there seems to be no way and bring blessing where life feels barren. Ultimately, they are instructed to leave the past behind, trust in God's faithfulness, and prepare their hearts for what he is about to do.

Scripture Reference: "Prepare Yourself For The New Season" : Isa. 43:1-28 (ESV)

Is. 43:1. But now thus says the Lord, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine
Is. 43:2. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.

Is. 43:9. All the nations gather together, and the peoples assemble. Who among them can declare this, and show us the former things? Let them bring their witnesses to prove them right, and let them hear and say, It is true.
Is. 43:10. You are my witnesses," declares the Lord, "and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe me and understand that I am he. Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me.
Is. 43:11. I, I am the Lord, and besides me there is no savior.
Is. 43:12. Is. 43:12 I declared and saved and proclaimed, when there was no strange god among you; and you are my witnesses," declares the Lord, "and I am God.

Is. 43:16. Thus says the Lord, who makes a way in the sea, a path in the mighty waters,
Is. 43:17. who brings forth chariot and horse, army and warrior; they lie down, they cannot rise, they are extinguished, quenched like a wick:
Is. 43:18. Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old.
Is. 43:19. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.
Is. 43:20. The wild beasts will honor me, the jackals and the ostriches, for I give water in the wilderness, rivers in the desert, to give drink to my chosen people,
Is. 43:21. the people whom I formed for myself that they might declare my praise.
Is. 43:22. Yet you did not call upon me, O Jacob; but you have been weary of me, O Israel!

Is. 43:28. Therefore I will profane the princes of the sanctuary, and deliver Jacob to utter destruction and Israel to reviling.
