Scriptural References: Isaiah.6:1-5, Revelation 5:1-14

Scripture Texts:

Isaiah 6:1 In the year that King Uzziah died I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and the train[a] of his robe filled the temple.

Isaiah 6 2 Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.

Isaiah 6 3 And one called to another and said:

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts;
the whole earth is full of his glory!"

Isaiah 6 4 And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke.

Isaiah 6 5 And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!"

Revelation 5.1 Then I saw in the right hand of him who was seated on the throne a scroll written within and on the back, sealed with seven seals.

Revelation 5.2 And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and break its seals?"

Revelation 5.3 And no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll or to look into it,

Revelation 5.4 and I began to weep loudly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it.

Revelation 5.5 And one of the elders said to me, "Weep no more; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has conquered, so that he can open the scroll and its seven seals."

Revelation 5.6 And between the throne and the four living creatures and among the elders I saw a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, with seven horns and with seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

and to open its seals,

for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God

from every tribe and language and people and nation,

Revelation 5.10 and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God,

and they shall reign on the earth."

Revelation 5.11 Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living

creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of

myriads and thousands of thousands,

Revelation 5.12 saying with a loud voice,

"Worthy is the Lamb who was slain,
