In Sept. 2018, FRIDLA made an oral agreement with Sons of Consolation (SOC) ministry in Augusta GA. FRIDLA was to move their office, workshop and warehouse from Rock Hill SC to Augusta GA and share the expenses of remodeling an old warehouse into offices, warehouse, etc. for both ministries. The object was for SOC to learn how to refurbish mobility equipment, ship to Latin America, and travel to those countries to work with the national volunteers to train them as wheelchair technicians to service, repair or replace the equipment as needed. The purpose of this partnership was to prepare SOC to continue the work after Judy Nunez could no longer do it.

In December 2018, Judy and Alberto sold their house in Rock Hill and moved to Aiken County, SC to be closer to the new facility. The staff at SOC had learned some of the technical aspect of the mobility ministry but had shown absolutely NO INTEREST in going overseas. Instead, they were pressuring Judy for access to FRIDLA's financial records and donor base. Judy told them the "ministry" would be turned over, but not the information on FRIDLA's current donors because the donors have supported Judy, as a missionary, for many years and she does not have peace asking her donors to continue as supporters of SOC.

In October 2019, refurbishing of the building was completed. At that point, SOC increased pressure for the turn-over of FRILDA's books. SOC became angry when Judy did not comply, and they demanded that FRIDLA no longer share expenses but instead, pay SOC a large monthly fee (which is more than sharing expenses).

Present day: In the middle of this Pandemic, FRIDLA has been given 60 days to move everything out of the warehouse. Judy feels that, indeed, FRIDLA must sever ties and move out as they do not want to leave all their equipment behind for SOC to sell. The cost to move the mobility equipment (enough to fill four tractor trailers) could run into thousands of dollars. Please pray for God's leading and provision for the future.
